Dear Mr. Anthony Martin,

Your assistance is required in a matter of grave importance involving actions or failure to act by the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals, and one or more of the following: Justice Margaret Workman, and four former West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals Justices, Robin Jean Davis, Brent D. Benjamin, Menis E. Ketchum II, and Allen H. Loughry II in regards to the handling of Supreme Court of Appeals Case, # 15-0491.

The mission of the office of the attorney general is responsible for ensuring that the rights of its citizens are protected in matters before the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals. **(See Exhibit A)**

On May 22, 2015, a complaint and demand was filed and stamped in the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals. I can supply the entire 37 page filing with certificates of service. As you can see, I am the first listed plaintiff in the case. **(See Exhibit B)**

On June 5, 2015, The Supreme Court of Appeals order was made and entered and assigned No. 15-0491. **(See Exhibit C)**

On September 4, 2015, Case # 15-0491 was amended to add and incorporate Justices, Margaret L. Workman, Robin Jean Davis, Brent D. Benjamin, Menis E. Ketchum II, and Allen H. Loughry II as defendants in the Original Complaint and Demand. I can supply the entire 7 page amended complaint and demand with certificates of service. **(See Exhibit D)**

Immediately after filing the amendment to Case # 15-0491 and in front of the Clerk's office, I video recorded and live-streamed the reading of the amended complaint. The 25 minute video is on YouTube at the following link: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=sx12XfSSPx0>

Once Case # 15-0491 was amended as stated, the five named Justices could not adjudicate the case further and five Circuit Court Justices would have to be called upon to continue the case. To this date, I, Phillip Hudok, plaintiff in Case # 15-0491 have not been served any notice from the

Supreme Court of Appeals. On October 6, 2015, I was interviewed by Staff Writer, Tim MacVean of the Elkins Inter-Mountain Newspaper. The featured story ran on the front page of the paper with the title "Justices added to Hudok's lawsuit." As you can see with from the newspaper and my insert of the image from the filed amendment, the story ran slightly over one month later. (See Exhibit E)

Since that time I have done several radio talk show interviews that have aired in West Virginia. A national news magazine carried the story, but I have never been received any response from the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals. Therefore, Case # 15-0491 is unresolved.

On January 3, 2016, Mr Patrick Morrissey stated the following on his Facebook Page: (See Exhibit F)

That I, Phillip Hudok, was involved in a pending case against the state of West Virginia and that he, Patrick Morrissey would defer communications with my attorney. That said, I cannot communicate with Mr. Morrissey in any way involving West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals Case # 15-0491.

Therefore, as Chief Deputy Attorney General, you must take action in what appears to be criminal behavior in the highest court in West Virginia. What really happened to Case # 15-0491? I, Phillip Hudok, plaintiff have received no finding of fact and conclusion of law! I have an interest in any upcoming case involving Chief Justice, Margaret Workman as a third party intervener.


Could 18 U.S. Code § 2071 - Concealment, removal, or mutilation generally apply?

"Whoever willfully and unlawfully conceals, removes, mutilates, obliterates, or destroys, or attempts to do so, or, with intent to do so takes and carries away any record, proceeding, map, book, paper, document, or other thing, filed or deposited with any clerk or officer of any court of the United States, or in any public office, or with any judicial or public officer of the United States, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than three years, or both."

Rule of law is paramount and we all share responsibility in its application. Concerning this specific issue, it is somewhat perplexing when informed legislators failed to act on conscience, let alone misprision of felony.

Please contact me at your earliest convenience regarding this matter. How, or if I need to pursue additional avenues depends on your intentions.

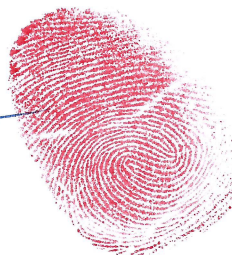


Mission of the Office of the Attorney General

The overarching mission of the Office of the Attorney General, as set forth in the West Virginia Constitution and the West Virginia Code, is to serve as the chief legal officer for the State of West Virginia. The Attorney General Speaks for the legal interests of the State.

Pursuant to the Attorney General's broad mission, the Office is responsible for providing skilled legal counsel and representation to the State, its officers, agencies, and boards on a wide range of legal matters. More specifically, the Office of the Attorney General is responsible for prosecuting and defending legal actions on behalf of the State, and for ensuring that the rights of the State and its citizens are protected in matters before the circuit courts of this State, the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals, and all federal courts. The Attorney General also is entrusted with enforcing the laws of the State as they related to consumer protection, unfair trade practices, civil rights, and other important areas. Additionally, the Office of the Attorney General may appoint outside attorneys to serve as special assistant attorneys general on certain legal matters.

Finally, the Office of the Attorney General plays a critical role with regard to state criminal law. In addition to providing advice and consultation to county prosecuting attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General has the exclusive responsibility for representing the state in all criminal appeals and in all habeas corpus proceedings filed by prisoners within the State.
